- 5. Is there central heating/air? Floor heaters?
- 6. What are the quiet hours?
- 7. What are the rules regarding trash and recycling?
- 8. Is the neighborhood safe?
- 9. How close is the nearest grocery store?
- 10. Is there enough space to store food for me and my roommates in the kitchen?
- 11. Is there enough space to cook?
- 12. Is there enough room to store extra stuff?
- 13. Is the apartment clean on the tour? It should be spotless. Is the apartment complex clean and well-kept?
- 14. Who do I call if something breaks within the apartment? How long does it take to get a response?
